School Scholarship Program Recognized National and Regional Accreditation Agencies

Pursuant to IC 20-51-1-4.7, the Indiana State Board of Education (SBOE) recognizes the following list of accrediting agencies. Schools may have current accreditation status with one of the agencies below as an alternative to accreditation via the SBOE.

- American Association of Christian Schools (AACS)
- Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI)

- Independent Schools Association of the Central States (ISACS)
- International Christian Accrediting Association (ICAA)
- National Lutheran Schools Accreditation (NLSA)
- North Central Association (NCA) / AdvancED / Cognia

Accrediting organizations for K-12 schools that are interested in being recognized may submit a petition to the SBOE for consideration. The notice of intent to submit a petition must be submitted between August 1 and September 1 prior to the school year for which the organization seeks recognition.
